Steps to drop your courses:

1. Login WebReg or UDSIS : <https://my.udel.edu/task/all/webreg>
2. Click on Courses & Enrollment
3. Click on Registration & Drop/Add
4. Students will see their schedule and they can click the drop button (red circle below) which is next to the course information.
5. Click Drop Course(s) as confirmation.

Fall Block A Courses: **September 14 – October 16**

Fall Block B Courses: **November 9– December 11**
