Applications for the Minor in Entrepreneurship are submitted through UDSIS and are reviewed twice a year. For Students admitted Fall 2019 - Present

The minor in Entrepreneurship helps students to acquire knowledge and skills that are useful across nearly all possible career paths from starting a business, to driving innovation within large companies, to developing sustainable solutions for social issues. The minor emphasizes experiential learning through startups (new business or social enterprises) to provide students with first-hand experience in developing innovative ideas and putting them into action.

The minor is open to students in all majors. Admission is based on the availability of seats. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.7 or better of the director's permission is required for admission.
