

New Policy for Submitting English Language Proficiency Score Reports

Accepted Tests and Minimum Score Requirements

You must take one of the following English proficiency tests to satisfy the degree admission requirement:

- **IELTS Academic:** Minimum score of 6.5

Note: IELTS scores are not combined; scores must be from a single test administration.

- **TOEFL iBT:** Minimum score of 79

Note: We do accept TOEFL MyBest scores.

- **Duolingo English Test:** Minimum score of 110

Not Accepted: TOEFL Home Edition, Gaokao English, PTE Academic



Submission of Official Scores: IELTS

*Students must request that official score reports be sent directly from the testing agency to the University of Delaware. The following submission methods apply:

To have your IELTS scores sent directly to UD, you need to request an official Test Report Form (TRF) from the test center.

You can do this through your IELTS booking portal or by contacting the testing center directly. You must send an official copy, not a photocopy, so be sure you request the original TRF.

How To: Locate the "Request a Test Report Form" or similar option within your booking portal. UD will accept reports delivered either through postal mail or via IELTS Results Service e-delivery.



Submission of Official Scores: TOEFL & Duolingo

*Students must request that official score reports be sent directly from the testing agency to the University of Delaware. The following submission methods apply:

TOEFL iBT: To send your TOEFL scores directly to UD, you need to designate them as a recipient through your ETS TOEFL account.

How To: You can do this either before or after your test, Look for the "Order Score Reports" or "Send Additional Score Reports" option in your account.

Select the Test: Choose the specific TOEFL iBT test for which you want to send scores.

Identify the Institute: Select University of Delaware or enter the UD institution code – 5811

Duolingo English Test: Share scores through your Duolingo account.



Score Submission Deadlines:

All scores must be received by the following deadlines (end of third year):

- Cohort 2022:** August 31, 2025 for fall semester admission to the major
January 15, 2026 for spring semester admission to the major
- Cohort 2023:** August 31, 2026 for fall semester admission to the major
January 15, 2027 for spring semester admission to the major
- Cohort 2024:** August 31, 2027 for fall semester admission to the major
January 15, 2028 for spring semester admission to the major
- Cohort 2025:** August 31, 2028 for fall semester admission to the major
January 15, 2029 for spring semester admission to the major



**What Happens if I Don't Submit a Score Report
by one of the Deadlines for my Cohort?**

Students who fail to submit official qualifying scores by the deadline will not be matriculated into their degree (Bachelor of Science) and major (OM, Finance, MISY).

In such cases: Academic transcripts will be marked "Continuing Education" & students will not receive their UD degree.



➤ **Recommendations and Additional Guidance:**

Students are strongly encouraged to take the IELTS, TOEFL or Duolingo exam well in advance of deadlines.

Keep in mind that multiple attempts may be required to achieve the minimum score. Early testing is advised to ensure you graduate on time, with your Cohort.
