### UD Undergraduate Courses to Fulfill Requirement for Waiver

ECON 603: Economic Analysis for Business Policy

ECON 103 (Intro. to Macroeconomics) **and** either ECON 300 (Intermediate Microeconomic Theory) **or** ECON 301 (Quantitative Economic Theory)

ACCT 600: Financial Reporting & Analysis

ACCT 207 (Accounting I – Financial Accounting) **and** ACCT 208 (Accounting 2 – Managerial Accounting)

BUAD 670: Managing People, Teams & Organizations

BUAD 309 (Organizational Behavior) **and** either:  
BUAD 386 (International Business Management) **or**  
BUAD 421 (Human Resource Management) **or**  
BUAD 422 (Leading Businesses Through Change) **or**  
BUAD 423 (Negotiation & Conflict Resolution) **or**  
BUAD 426 (Leadership and Teams)  
BUAD 430 (Consulting & Project Management) **or**  
BUAD 444 (Small Business Management)

BUAD 680: Marketing Management

BUAD 301 (Introduction to Marketing) **and** either:  
BUAD 302 (Marketing Research) **or**  
BUAD 476 (Marketing Analytics) **or**

BUAD 631: Operations Management & Management Science

BUAD 306 (Introduction to Service and Operations Management) **and** BUAD 346 (Analytical Decision Making)

FINC 650: Financial Management

FINC 311 (Principles of Finance) **and** FINC 312 (Intermediate Financial Management)

- Up to 2 courses (6 credits) from the MBA core requirements can be waived for the 38-credit MBA.
- A grade of “B” or better is required in each course to qualify for a waiver.
- The courses must have been taken at an AACSB-accredited institution within the past 5 years.
- All courses are 3 credit hours.
