- Minimum grade of 'B' required for waivers
- Dual MBA degrees are not eligible for waivers
- Up to 2 courses (6 credits) may be waived in the 38-credit MBA
- Up to 4 courses (12 credits) may be waived in the 44-credit MBA
- Undergraduate courses must be from an AACSB-accredited school taken within 5 years
